Dublin Taiko Uniform Policy

A key part of Dublin Taiko performances is our uniforms. With over 120 students participating in the program, uniform procurement and maintenance requires a significant investment in volunteer time and booster funds. In order to continue to keep our pay-to-play fees low, we are requiring students and parents to commit to the proper care of their uniforms as a condition of participation in Dublin Taiko.

The following document must be signed by the participating student and a parent/guardian prior to issue of a Taiko uniform. This form is to be returned with your pay-to-play form. Until the signed form has been returned, your student may not practice, will not receive a uniform, and may miss the opportunity to participate in performances.

Uniform Policy:

- Upon issue, it is expected that the uniform and the uniform bag will be properly maintained while in your student's care. Uniform will be inspected with student during issue.
- Student should not place items other than their uniform in the protective bag.
- Uniforms should be washed in cold water with like colors.
- Uniforms must be ironed before each performance. Please take care when pressing the uniform to not make contact with the screen printing on the Happi. This will melt the screen printing and ruin the Happi.
- Uniforms are to be returned at the end of the school year on dates to be determined at a later time.
- A parent must be present to return the uniform directly to an adult Taiko team member on the specified the return date. It cannot be sent to school with your student or returned to the Taiko Director.
- Students who have not returned a uniform from a prior year will not be issued a new uniform until prior year's uniforms are returned or paid for. While they will be permitted to attend practice, they will not have the opportunity to participate in performances.
- Uniforms are expected to be returned in their entirety: cleaned, ironed, and free of lint and pet hair. Charges will be incurred if these conditions are not met. You can view a list of charges on the next page.
- At the time of return, we will inspect the uniform with a parent, discuss charges if applicable, and have you sign-off on the uniform.
- **NEW:** A \$25 late fee will be assessed for any student who does not return their uniform in a timely manner at the end of the season.
- If a uniform is not returned, student and parent agree to pay a replacement fee of \$120.00.
